Town of Londonderry and Londonderry School District Break Ground on New School District Offices in Landmark Collaborative Effort

LONDONDERRY, NH — On June 23, 2026, representatives from the Town of Londonderry and the Londonderry School District will officially break ground on the future site of the new School District Administrative Offices. The ceremony will begin at 3 p.m., and the public is welcome to attend. Located directly adjacent to Londonderry Town Hall, this project marks the beginning of a historic partnership designed to maximize municipal efficiency and deliver significant long-term savings to local taxpayers.

Londonderry's School District Office project is set apart by its innovative, fiscally responsible funding structure. Rather than burdening residents with long-term bond financing and high interest rates, the Town and the School District worked together and combined their respective fund balances to cover the cost of the building. The School District will pay back the Town's \$2.5 million contribution interest-free over ten years.

The partnership started in July 2025 when the Town and School formed an official working group to discuss alternatives to leasing space for the School District Offices. This group worked together to share information and partner with the community throughout the planning process. The Town Council and School Board both moved the plan to fund the build using existing fund balances from each entity to the March 2026 ballots. The project received overwhelming community support, and voters approved the construction on both the Town and School ballots.

The construction of the School District Administrative Office building removes the need for the commercial lease that the School District has been paying since 2018 on 6A Kitty Hawk Landing, permanently eliminating this ongoing operational expense for taxpayers while returning District personnel back to the center of Town and closer to the schools they support.

This venture represents an unprecedented level of collaboration between the Londonderry Town government and School District. By aligning shared resources and goals, the School District Administrative Office delivers a permanent solution that respects the taxpayer's dollar while creating a centralized municipal hub for our community.
